**Development** - The committee continues to follow its Development Plan and has many initiatives to increase the numbers playing around the county. Quarterly data collected from 27 Essex clubs has shown sustainable growth over the last few years, player per court ratio continues to rise despite loss of courts at Springhealth.

## Financial Report - Elaine Oddie

The accounts up until 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019 were presented. Income and expense elements were reviewed in detail and show a surplus of £967 with reserves of £18143 as of May 31<sup>st</sup> 2019 (full accounts available on request)

Elaine went on to the 2019/2020 budget, I/C team expenses are continually reviewed and the budgets allocated accordingly, 2019/2020 will field the same number of teams as 2019/2018, a small amount of the reserve may go towards funding development which to date has been covered through ES grants.

Dawn Robinson (Hamptons) requested that due to the surplus was there a possibility of Team shirts for the next county session being funded by ESRA – this was accepted for review at the next committee meeting

**Adoption of Accounts** - There was some discussion, the meeting was asked to approve the accounts and proposed 2019/2020 Budgets:

Proposed – Carey Adams (Epping), Seconder – Mark Kirkman (Epping)

Adoption of the Accounts was carried unanimously.

**Election of Officers** - Geoff Went confirmed that, he would like to step down as secretary but if no volunteers then he would continue. Also there were nominations from the floor to fill the vacancies Greg Foxon was proposed. There was some discussion and the meeting was asked to approve the proposed ESRA committee for the coming year:

**Election of ESRA Officers** - There was some discussion and requests from the Chair for nominations to fill other vacant positions, the meeting was asked to approve the proposed ESRA committee for the coming year:

## Any Other Business (AGM) – David Neller

**2020 County Closed** – Due to Kingswood not wanting to host the Essex Closed it was opened up to the floor for propose venues - Seff Burwood suggested that Bishop Stratford would possibly be interested but would confirm with the manager of the club and advise if this was possible. It was agreed this should proceed with the January dates (25<sup>th</sup> & 26<sup>st</sup> Jan 2020), but was open to change if this did not suit Bishop Stortford.

**Masters/Off Peak Leagues** – It was agreed this would be a good idea but no volunteers came forward to offer to manage.

**IC Team Selection** – It was agreed should update the existing squad lists with available players and that each captain should maintain and use these lists.



**Player Levy** – Driving and maintaining development and consequent growth in the sport requires a funded resource. The current ES funding will end soon, it was agreed that we should continue using existing grants and consider how best to improve/increase income (should it be required) for proposal at the next AGM

## Joint League Meeting

**Leagues** - the men’s and ladies were stable using the Resultsandnews LMS. Again this year Racketball had failed to start as in previous years - this is a great disappointment after several years of progress; some new initiatives are required.

The On-line league management system continues with very few issues. The Ladies league have shown an interest and this will be implemented in the near future.

**Clubs** - some clubs have been active reporting their events especially Gidea Park and Walthamstow

**Punctuality & Late Changes** – Home & away teams arriving late for matches, late changes to fixtures has led to some serious issues with venues. This coupled with venues closing earlier means in some instances matches have been disrupted and hosting become an issue. This will be discussed at the separate men’s & ladies league meetings

**Paul Howell** – proposed a change to the Men’s league rules whereby “**each Team captain would exchange written team sheet sowing their 1-5 for the NIGHT before the matches start**”. This would help to stop the disagreements as to which order of merit some people play – This will be reviewed and discussed at the Men’s league meeting.

Justin Walton from The Squash club business network gave a Short presentation supported by a video explaining how the activity works around the county.
